

Privacy Policy for Codesthq.com

1. Yieldbird pays particular attention to the protection of the privacy of its Clients. This applies both to technical measures used and to organisational methods applied in order to ensure the protection of the data disclosed to Yieldbird for processing.

2. Yieldbird processes the following personal data of its Clients: e-mail address, company name, name and surname and phone number.

3. Yieldbird secures the data disclosed to it against further disclosure to unauthorised third parties, which includes processing such data in breach of the provisions of generally applicable law. Yieldbird constantly controls the process of data processing, giving relevant authorisations for processing only under Client's consent or if it is necessary for the correct realisation of the Service.

5. The basis for authorising Yieldbird to process the personal data of the Clients is the consent given by the Clients or a statutory authorisation to process the data necessary for the correct realisation of the Service.

6. Disclosing any of the personal data is voluntary.

7. The Client has the right to access the content of their data and to correct it.

8. The data disclosed by the Client User are used for the purposes of correct realisation of the Service and for the marketing purposes of Yieldbird.

9. The contact data are also used by Yieldbird for sending information about Yieldbird and about services it provides to its Clients. The Client can resign from being sent such type of information at any time.

10. The Client has the possibility of viewing, modifying and removing the personal data disclosed to Yieldbird for processing.

11. The service uses "cookies", which collect the information allowing for the adjustment of services and content in order to better satisfy the needs of the Clients. They are also used to

make metric research and develop statistics of the Clients' use of the Service. Disabling "cookies" is possible by Client's changing the preferences of their browser.
